

Glorious Jackets

Class description

Quilts are not just for the bedroom anymore. This class will show you how to create a glorious jacket. This loose fitting jacket's foundation is a sweatshirt. Then using border, theme prints or coordinating fat quarters from your stash you'll be able to complete this stylish jacket. Add a bit of free motion stitching, metallic thread and or beads and you'll have a really glorious jacket.

Supply List

1 sweatshirt (lightweight)—washed, dried and pressed. The color of the sweatshirt doesn't matter if it is being totally covered.

Before class remove ribbing from the sleeve cuffs, bottom and neck of the sweatshirt. Also remove the sleeves from the sweatshirt.

Chalk markers

Sharpie marker in colors that can be seen on dark or light color sweatshirt

Scissors for fabric cutting

Ruler-6 1/2" x 24" works best

Seam Ripper

Straight pins

Cutting mat-medium or large size

Rotary cutter

machine needles-quilting and free motion (topstitch if using metallic)

Free Motion foot

Assorted threads-regular and decorative

1-2 yards of Pellon Wonder Under

2-3 yards fabric-Border or theme prints, assorted coordinating fat quarters or you may construct your jacket with just fat quarters or other interesting fabrics.

2-3 packages of Double Fold Bias Tape and Extra Wide Double Fold Bias Tape or enough fabric to make your own bias tape.
