For over 35 years Walt has been creating and designing jewelry. In order to achieve some of his creative designs he has

developed some unique techniques. Since moving back to the coast Walt has been concentrating his efforts in designing one-of-a-kind jewelry and precious metal sculptures.

Walt believes jewelry should be an adornment to the human body, just as a painting is to a room, or a sculpture is to that special place in a home, or yard. His works-of-art in jewelry or treasured pre-


