### What Will You Be Selling at the Dolphin's Holiday Boutique?

People wishing to consign their handcrafted items to the Dolphin Gallery for sale in the Christmas Boutique may bring them to the Dolphin either on **Sunday, November 19, between noon and 4 p.m.**, or on **Monday, November 20, between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.** We are adding Sunday this year to better accommodate those with conflicting work schedules. Please mark your calendars now so you don't miss participating in this fun event! The commission to consignors of boutique items is 75% of the sale price, with Gualala Arts receiving 25%. The Holiday Boutique will be open and ready for eager shoppers starting on **Tuesday, November 21**, and continuing through New Year's Eve. Please plan to pick up your unsold items on **Tuesday or Wednesday, January 2 or 3**. The Dolphin's regular store hours are 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. daily. They will be closed on Christmas Day and New Year's Day but may be open on Thanksgiving depending on availability of volunteers. ### Be in the New Studio Guide

The first issue of the Studio Guide, sponsored by Gualala Arts and organized by C.E. Brown, was available to the visitors of the Art in the Redwoods Festival. It is a tri-fold brochure listing artists' names, addresses, phone numbers, art form with description of the work, e-mail address, or website. The idea is to offer visitors a year-round opportunity to visit artists in their studios. By calling to make an appointment, art patrons and collectors can have a one-on-one visit at the artist's convenience.

Sale is on Saturday morning, October 14 from only 9 to 11 a.m. Be there on time for the best bargains. Donations are tax-deductible and all proceeds go to support the art programs at Gualala Arts.

### Collaborative Art Show in June, 2007

Gualala Arts will host an exhibition in the Jacob Foyer of collaborations – art works created by two or more artists working together. All works must be made of non-art materials or art materials used in a non-traditional way. A catalog of the exhibit and exhibitors is being planned along with postcards advertising the exhibit. If you would like to be in this show, we invite you to submit a proposal. Proposals will be juried by Suzan Friedland, Hansine Goran, David "Sus" Susalla, and Jane Reichhold.

Proposals must be received at Gualala Arts by January 30, 2007. The selected artists will be notified by February 12, 2007. It is planned that each participating artist will get one copy of the show's catalog and 50 postcards.

#### How to submit a proposal:

- Title of the work
- Artists' names and addresses
- List of materials and size of work
- Description of the work including hanging or mounting requirements.
- A photo or drawing of the proposed work
- You may submit up to three proposals. There is no entry fee or charge for proposals. The entry fee for accepted work is \$15 per artist per work.
- Accepted artists will be asked to sign a contract agreeing to install a work which is entirely the two or more artists' own, original design on June 6, 7, 8, 2007. Participating artists will be responsible for supplying either a photo of the work, or an ink drawing suitable for publication in the catalog, by March 15, 2007. Artists can also make the labels for each of their works.
- Qualifying artists will be given the opportunity of purchasing additional catalogs at a prepublication price.
- Proposals will be accepted from artists who are members of Gualala Arts, Pacific Piecemakers Quilt Guild, or North Coast Artists Guild. If you are not yet a member, you may join Gualala Arts at this time.

#### Schedule:

- Proposals must be submitted to Gualala Arts by January 30, 2007.
- Accepted artists will be notified by February 12.
- Materials submitted for the catalog by March 15.
- Artwork must be installed in the foyer of Gualala Arts on June 6, 7, or 8, by appointment.
- Your artwork must be taken down by July 9.
