The workshops are intended to be a relaxing, yet informative, painting experience. Students will paint on location at selected sites that offer an abundance of outstanding subject matter. Participants will meet each day at 9 a.m. for a short briefing and instructions. The morning hours are primarily used by the students to pursue their painting assignments. Group discussions and lunch will take place from 12 noon to 1 p.m. Afternoon instruction and group critiques will conclude at 3 p.m. Following class, students may elect to continue their own painting endeavors independently or watch Fred undertake a watercolor painting of his own. Students will explore traditional, conceptual, and innovative watercolor approaches that will further develop and enhance their own personal style of

painting. Teaching methods consist of demonstrations, lectures, critiques, and individual assistance.
