### Chinese Folk Painting Exhibition

The 2007 China Xiuzhou International Folk Painting Exhibition of the 3rd Chinese Peasant Painting Art Festival is to be held from October 26, to November 26, 2007. Sponsored by the Chinese Peasant Painting Art Center, Xiuzhou, Jiaying, Zhejiang, China, the show will contain idyllic painting, screen painting, oil painting, gouache, watercolor, and pastels.

There is no fee for artists' groups outside China and these groups or organizations may submit up to 10 works maximum with no more than three works by one person. The size of the finished work should be no larger than 80cm square. Frames may be added by Chinese sponsors. The submission shall consist of a 25 mm slide of framed work, or a 6 inch photograph, or a jpg no less than 200 kb, application form, description, duplicate of ID (or passport), and recent photo of artist. Delivery may be made in person or by post. Selection method will be on September 10.

Selection and determination will be done by professionals chosen by organizing committee, which will issue a participation certificate for those selected. Foreign artists may qualify for subsidy of expenses (exclusive of airfare).

The theme of the exhibition is "Harmonious World and Colorful Life," which is promoting artistic communication between folk painting schools around the world to enhance understanding and friendship, and to contribute to the development of folk painting. This is a wonderful opportunity to reach out on a cultural level through the medium of visual art.
