A year ago, the Gualala Arts Board realized that we needed a major fundraising plan to ensure that our arts center is adequately maintained going forward and that Gualala Arts has the necessary funding for new projects and personnel. These are budget issues for both the present and the future. Concerns were expressed about long range building projects, such as a new roof and an elevator, but the Board also acknowledged that we are facing some critical issues related to deferred maintenance.

In response, the Board identified a committee to set direction and prioritize and energize fundraising efforts. But the committee can not achieve these goals by themselves; the entire Gualala Arts membership needs to be behind the fundraising efforts to secure the Arts Center facilities and programs for the future.

We have made an excellent start in 2007 (see David 'Sus' Susalla's Annual Report Summary,) with plans for a continued focus on fundraising in 2008 and beyond. Besides direct contributions of services and money, more members are expressing their faith in the future of Gualala Arts by making promises of future bequests.
