A PPQG Exhibit RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- This exhibit is only open to Pacific Piecemaker Guild members and members of their families. Guild memberships are \$40 per year.

PREPARING ENTRIES

- No supplemental labels, descriptions, books, promotional materials, etc., are allowed next to or around an entry. A binder with one 8.5” x 11” sheet of paper per entry will provide a description of the entry and/or the artist’s biography. The binder will be available in the gallery for public viewing.
- Quilts must be labelled with artist’s name and quilt title at the back of the lower right corner when facing the front of the quilt.
- Quilts **MUST** be accompanied by hanging rods labeled with the quilter’s name. Each rod must be an inch shorter than its quilt’s width and must not show when the quilt is hung. (Each quilt must also have an appropriately sized sleeve for the rod.) Only correctly labeled hanging rods will be returned with quilts on pickup day.

FEES

- Quilts available for purchase will have no entry fee.
- Entry fees for NFS (not for sale) items will be \$20.

COMMISSIONS

- Gualala Arts will retain 30% commission on all sales of entries made during the course of the exhibit. Price accordingly.
- Checks for artwork sold will be mailed to the artist within two weeks of the end of the month in which it was sold.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

- Please print clearly, fill in all contact blanks, and double-check spelling. Be sure to sign the entry form.

ARTWORK DELIVERY

- Deliver artwork Monday, May 2, Noon – 3p.m., to the Gualala Arts Center at 46501 Old State Hwy, Gualala.
- Gualala Arts will not accept shipped or mailed entries. No exceptions!

POST SHOW PICK UP

- Unsold work must stay up for the entire exhibit; however, buyers may take purchased artwork after the opening reception.
- Artists must claim unsold work by Monday, MAY 30 between Noon – 3p.m. p.m.
- Gualala Arts is not responsible for artwork not picked up by end of business May 30 and will charge \$5 per day per piece for storage.

RESPONSIBILITY

- Gualala Arts, Inc. is not responsible for loss, theft, or damage of artworks entered in the show.
- Exhibitors are solely responsible for their work and should insure work if they desire. Gualala Arts may require proof of insurance if a work is priced over \$5,000.
- Gualala Arts will not ship purchases. If an entry requires mailing to a potential purchaser, Gualala Arts will contact the artist. If the artist wishes to package and mail the piece to the buyer, Gualala Arts will complete the purchase.
- Submission of an entry implies acceptance of all conditions stated in this document.
