### Materials and tools needed:

#### Fabric:

Background to motif – 1 yd

Pleated trim – ½ yd WOF (width of fabric)

Motif petals and binding – ½ y

Inserts - fat quarter or ¼ yd

batting and fabric for backing (28" sq approx.)

(feel free to bring several fabric fat quarters to audition and explore. These projects are fun to play with and expand our color sense!)

#### Tools:

Working sewing machine (Singer Classics will work)

Rotary Cutter, ruler and small cutting surface

June Tailor Grid Marker (I will bring a couple so no worries if you do not have one.

Thread, scissors, pins, seam rippers, hand sewing needles, etc.

Our goal is to have fun and play with fabric. I have worked with many people who have created this project and there has never been an ugly one!
