Exhibit Statement: The Gualala Salon exhibit will be a juried and judged fine art show. The purpose of this exhibit is to showcase outstanding visual art and artists without regard to the type of media.

1. Registration fee: \$15 for one entry, \$25 for two entries. Registration fees waived for Artist under age 18. Up to two entries allowed per artist.
2. This show is juried and judged. All work submitted will be juried by the judge into the Gualala Salon (accepted work) or the Salon des Refusés (rejected work). Accepted work will be exhibited in the Burnett Gallery and will be eligible for the First [\$1250] Second [\$1000] and Third [\$750] Place awards.
3. Rejected (refused) work will be exhibited in the Elaine Jacob Foyer and elsewhere throughout the Gualala Arts Center, and will be eligible for the People's Choice Awards of \$125, \$100, and \$75. There will be a special Judges Award of \$100 for the best work by an artist under eighteen years of age.
4. Please fill out an Entry Form for EACH piece. Turn in the top portion to Gualala Arts, with entry fee by the deadline. When delivering the art, attach the Entry Label portion securely to each piece. Keep the Artist Receipt for your personal record of what you are exhibiting
5. The Entry Form provides basic information for the exhibit "Title Card" which is created by Gualala Arts. A "Title Card" will be displayed beside each piece. The information will include the unique Tracking Number, Artist's name, Title, Media and the Selling Price. It is essential that this information is correct, since this information is used to track sales and send checks to artists.
6. For this exhibit, artists are encouraged to use all media, 2-D and 3-D. The work submitted should be no more than 2 years old and may not have been exhibited publically on the Mendonoma coast at any time in past.
7. Gualala Arts will retain 30% commission on all sales of entries (and multiples) made during the course of the exhibit
8. An "Artist Statement" is required; a photograph is optional for each artist. Please submit with your Entry Forms or bring when art is delivered to Gualala Arts. The curator will provide a binder to display with exhibit.
9. Please ensure all artwork is professionally prepared for hanging or display (no saw-tooth hangers, no "clip frames", etc.) and can be displayed with minimum of effort. NO screws or anchor bolts will be used for hanging; if needed, modify your art to be hung by wire & picture hanger. Gualala Arts is not liable for the loss, theft or damage of any art work or installation, at any point in the process.
10. Make checks payable to Gualala Arts and send to Gualala Arts Center, C/O Gualala Salon, PO Box 244, Gualala, CA, 95445.
11. The Exhibit Opening Reception will be 12/1/17, from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Generous donors will be providing catered food.
12. Judge(s) will be announced at a later date on the Gualala Arts website.
