## *Pacific Piecemakers Quilt Guild (PPQG)*

The theme is "Journeys." Inspiration may come from travel, a life experience, an accomplishment, a dream. There is no size limitation but each piece must include a specific piece of "Scrollscape Indigo" fabric from 'Quilted Treasures.' A five inch square of this fabric must be identifiable on the front of the quilt; it may be cut into small pieces, pieced into the quilt top, applied or fused, incorporated in an embellishment or used in the border. Acceptable sizes of the "Scrollscape Indigo" fabric for mini-quilts are as follows: quilts of fat quarter size or smaller, the minimum "Scrollscape Indigo" fabric must be 3 square inches. If very small – (postcard size 4"x 6" or smaller) 1 ½ sq inches of "Scrollscape Indigo" must be used on the front of the piece.

1. Registration fee is \$20.00 per entry if the item is not for sale. Make checks payable to Gualala Arts and include with your entry/registration form. While there is no limit on number of entries, please indicate your order of preference if hanging space becomes a problem.
2. Please fill out an Entry Form for EACH piece. Turn in the top portion to Gualala Arts, with entry fee, if applicable, by the deadline. When delivering the art, attach the Entry Label portion securely to each piece.
3. This show will NOT be juried and is open only to PPQG members in good standing
4. For this exhibit, artists are encouraged to enter 2-D or 3-D work. The work submitted should be no more than 2 years old and may not have been exhibited publically on the Mendonoma coast at any time in past.
5. Gualala Arts will retain 30% commission on all sales of entries (and multiples) made during the course of the exhibit.
6. The curator will provide a binder to display an "Artist

Statement" for each artist. Please submit with your Entry Forms.

7. Prepare your quilt for hanging: Each quilt entry should have a 4" hanging sleeve and a dowel or slat that measures 1" less than the width of the quilt. Artist name and quilt title should be on the dowel or slat. Mini-quilts may have a 2" hanging sleeve with a dowel measuring 1" less than width of quilt. A sleeve is not required for postcards
8. Quilts must interpret the "Journeys" theme and include the required "Scrollscape Indigo" fabric.
9. All quilts, except postcards, must have a label stating the quilt title, name of artist, date and location --stitched onto the quilt back in the lower right corner.
10. Gualala Arts is not liable for any art work or installation, at any point in the process.
11. Quilts must be picked up between 10:00am & 2:00pm Thursday Nov. 15. There will be a \$5.00 per day fee charged by GAC for those remaining after Nov. 15.
12. The Exhibit Opening Reception will be October 5, 2018, 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Please try to attend and bring finger food to share.
