Box 244, Gualala, CA 95445, or drop them off at the Gualala Arts Center office by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, April 14, 2015. Electronic Microsoft Word or PDF file submissions are also accepted. Send to info@!gualalaarts.org to arrive by the deadline. All decisions by the judges are final.

Winners will be notified by May 8. Contest sponsors strongly encourage all winners to attend the Awards Ceremony on Tuesday, May 12, 2015, at 7 p.m.at the Gualala Arts Center in order to read their work and receive their awards.
