These 3D flying wire birds are notoriously active and flying and hand formed using my self-invented, wire meshing technique. Average bird's wingspans may range 6"-36" in small, medium and large sizes, plus larger commissioned pieces. All are derived from live birding sketches. Multi-bird installations are designed for galleries, stores, homes and gardens. Custom installation consultation available by request.

Picture this, a wire line drawing forming a face or bird with a single strand. Or, create a scribble-volume form drawing of a bird. Now do that with wire. It's the Christmas lights theory. But our tangled mass is hand molded to form a 3D bird. Ceiling hung, these flying wire sculptures become shadow play mobiles. Spotlighted... watch them move and make shadow drawings on the wall. More spotlights, more animated shadow drawings. Color spotlights added, enhance décor effect.
