

## **Exhibit Proposal Information**

We are pleased that you are interested in exhibiting your work or curating a show with us at the Gualala Arts Center. The Exhibit Committee, in consultation with the Executive Director, David "Sus" Susalla, will plan the calendar year of exhibitions for the foyer, gallery and main auditorium. The committee follows the guidelines of the Gualala Arts Exhibition Policy. Please note that Art in the Redwoods is a separate committee.

The Gualala Arts exhibit calendar for this year has been filled. On occasion we have exhibits that are cancelled due to causes beyond our control. We like to have exhibit proposals on record that could be assembled very quickly if needed. We are still accepting back up exhibits for the current year. We will also consider small special interest exhibits for special areas of the building and grounds. Please feel free to offer proposals or talk to our Executive Director.

Exhibition proposals for next year are due in the Gualala Arts Center office before March 31 and notification of acceptance of proposals will be no later than April 30 for the next calendar year. A person can submit more than one proposal for any calendar year.
