

Waterwheel

Class Description:

Learn to paper piece the Judy Niemeyer way! Judy is known internationally for creative, innovative paper piecing designs, and her process and organization tips can be used on all your quilting projects. You will be guided by Certified Instructor, Jeanette Walton, who has taken training workshops with Judy and has access to all the up to date information on Judy's patterns and techniques! Waterwheel (40" x 40") is a Cut Loose pattern, aimed at the paper piecing beginner who wants to try out a fast project or learn a new technique.

Waterwheel Supply List:

Pattern: \$31

- 12" Add-a-quarter ruler (not required, but highly recommended)
- 6" by 12" ruler
- One piece of Template Plastic (3" by 12" piece) for fold template. Cardstock can also be used.
- Size 70/10 sharp needles
- High quality cotton sewing thread
- Glue Pen (Fons and Porter or Sewline recommended)
- Fabric glue stick – (UHU stick/Elmer glue stick recommended)
- Flower head pins or pins of your choice
- 3 – 1 Gallon Ziploc style plastic bags for organizing fabrics and papers
- Jumbo trombone style paper clips
- Medium size cutting mat (18" by 24")
- Rotary cutter
- Machine in good working order with $\frac{1}{4}$ foot (no guard).

Fabrics:

- (2) – $\frac{3}{8}$ yd contrasting fabrics (Round 1: Center)
- (2) – $\frac{1}{2}$ yd contrasting fabrics (Round 2)
- (2) – $\frac{7}{8}$ yd contrasting fabrics (Round 3)
- 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ yds border, backing, and binding
