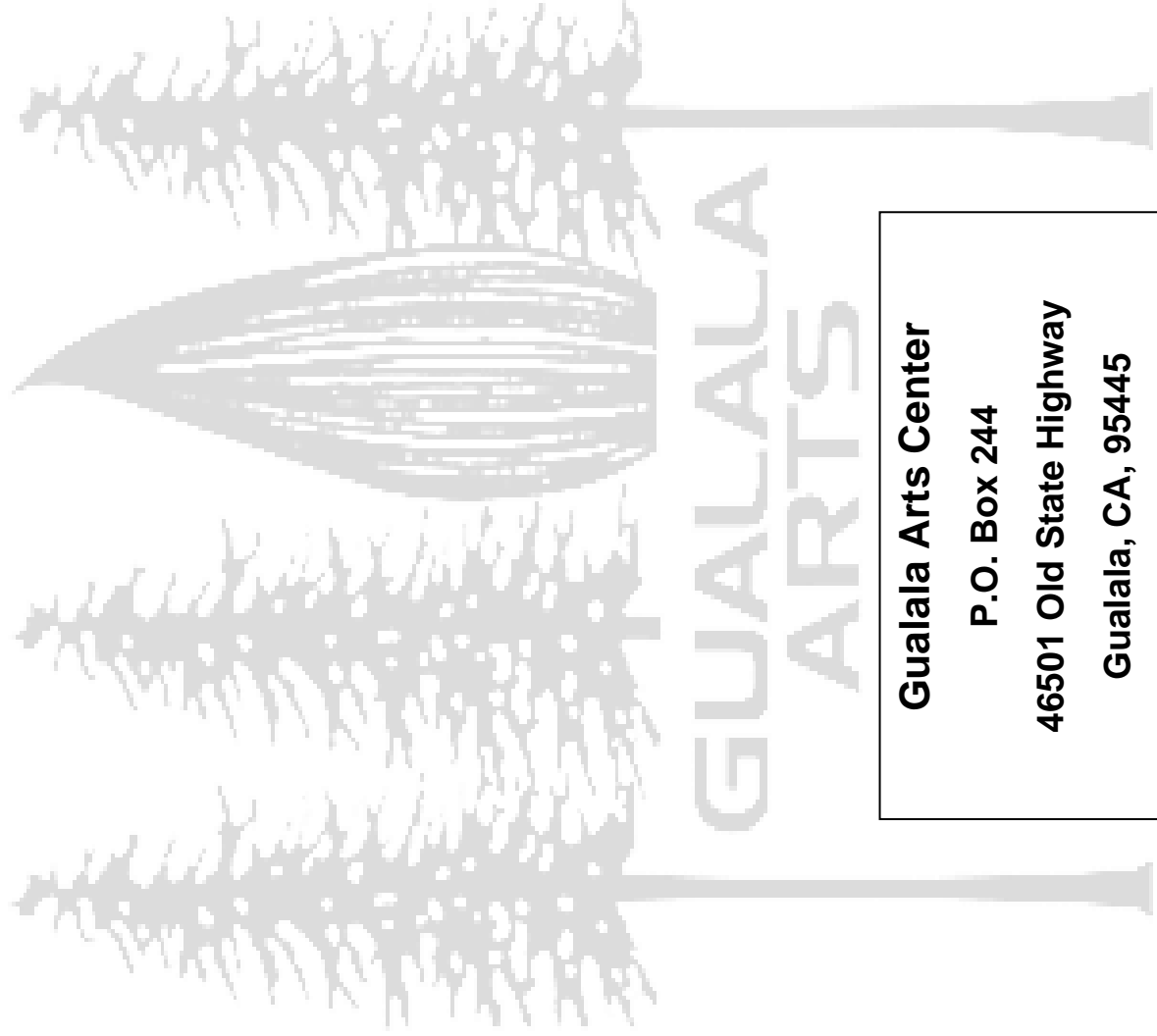

Exhibit Statement: The Point Arena Light Station was established on September 30, 1869 and the original tower was first lit on May 1, 1870. 2020 represents the 150th anniversary of the Point Arena Lighthouse lighting the way on the coast. This exhibit is intended to celebrate this significant sesquicentennial of a Mendocino coast icon. The exhibit is open to all types of visual media, i.e. painting, photography, sculpture, fabric arts, ceramics, mixed media, woodworking, jewelry, etc. inspired by the Lighthouse and the coast that it protects and represents.

1. Registration fee: \$10 per for sale entries, \$20 per Not For Sale (NFS) entries. Up to two entries allowed per artist. Registration fee waived for artists under 18.
2. This show will NOT be juried, but it will be judged and the following prizes will be awarded:
 - First Place (In Memory of Luciano Zamboni) - \$500
 - Second Place - \$300
 - Third Place - \$150
 - Young Artist First Place - \$100
 - Young Artist Second Place - \$50
 - Young Artist Third Place - \$25
 - Judge's Awards – Recognition Ribbon
 - People's Choice award - Recognition RibbonAll winners will also receive a Point Arena Lighthouse 150th Anniversary cloisonné pin. Other awards may be added before the exhibit opens.
3. Please fill out an Entry Form for EACH piece. Turn in the top portion to Gualala Arts, with entry fee by the deadline. When delivering the art, attach the Entry Label portion securely to each piece. Keep the Artist Receipt for your personal record of what you are exhibiting

4. The Entry Form provides basic information for the exhibit "Title Card" which is created by Gualala Arts. A "Title Card" will be displayed beside each piece. The information will include the unique Tracking Number, Artist's name, Title, Media and the Selling Price. It is essential that this information is correct, since this information is used to track sales and send checks to artists.
5. For this exhibit, artists are encouraged to use all media, 2-D and 3-D. Previously exhibited work is welcomed!
6. Gualala Arts will retain 30% commission on all sales of entries (and multiples) made during the course of the exhibit.
7. An "Artist Statement" is required; a photograph is optional for each artist. Please submit with your Entry Forms or bring with art upon delivery to Gualala Arts. The curator will provide a binder to display with exhibit.
8. Please ensure all artwork is professionally prepared for hanging or display (no saw-tooth hangers, no "clip frames", etc.) and can be displayed with minimum of effort. NO screws or anchor bolts will be used for hanging; if needed, modify your art to be hung by wire & picture hanger. Gualala Arts is not liable for any art work or installation, at any point in the process.
9. Entries will be eligible for People's Choice Award, no prize money will be given but winners are eligible for bragging rights.
10. Make checks payable to Gualala Arts and send to Gualala Arts Center, C/O Our Lighthouse, PO 244, Gualala, CA, 95445.
11. The Exhibit Opening Reception will be 4/3/20, 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Please try to attend and bring finger food to share.
