**Update Letter from the Executive Director**

The following is an excerpt of the update of our current situation as of May 14, 2021.

- **GREAT NEWS! Gualala Arts Center doors ARE OPEN!** We are open for retail sales of art 7 days a week (11am to 4pm). The Global Harmony Sculpture Garden also remains open 7 days a week. **Many thanks to the staff, artists and volunteers for creating a safe environment to embrace our challenges and rising to this occasion!**

- **“Safety First” is the common theme for keeping the Arts Center doors open!** The staff at Gualala Arts has created a safe environment to stroll the halls with each room having: fresh Pacific breezes running through open doors, ceiling fans spinning above, air purifiers, sanitizer at entrance, central heat with dedicated furnace, ventilation filters, masks required from front gates of property, one person allowed in restroom at a time, requested to remain 6 feet apart outside and 12 feet inside, We have literally been up all night thinking of ways to go above and beyond any requirements for the safety of our volunteers, staff and visitors.

- **More great news Mendocino County has moved into the Yellow Tier.** With that said, and out of an abundance of caution, Gualala Arts and the Dolphin Gallery will continue to follow the protocols of the more restrictive orange tier but increasing our numbers of people per gallery. Our current plan is to stay one tier behind the current allowed. So far these numbers have been effective at keeping people safe and comfortable with minimal waiting while strolling through our sculpture garden. **Even though the CDC has issued new guidance about facemasks and distancing, Gualala Arts falls under the jurisdiction of Mendocino County and the State of California guidelines.** We will need to continue following our current set of protocols but assume the county will use this information to update their requirements.

Hygiene protocol is employed to keep all our guests safe including the following but not limited to:

- Limited guests in building - one family pod per room at one time.
- Staff and volunteers temperature checked and logged in if staying longer than 15 minutes.
- Masks are required to be worn by all when entering property.
- Social distancing will be observed - 6 feet outside 12 feet inside.
- Hand sanitizer & hand washing will be available for all guests.
- State of the art air purifiers in each room.
- Doors and windows open to allow for plenty of fresh air (dress warm!).
