

Hygiene protocol is employed to keep all our guests safe including the following but not limited to:

- Masks are required to be worn by all unvaccinated visitors when entering property and building.
- Masks are REQUIRED FOR EVERYONE INDOORS until further notice.
- Masks are encouraged by all for outdoor events unless actively eating or drinking.
- Gualala Arts is allowing volunteers and visitors to "self attest" that they are fully vaccinated to visit the grounds unmasked at this point.
- Gualala Arts Staff will be masked while inside of building during regular public hours 7 days a week 11-4 pm.
- Social distancing will be observed for all visitors: 6-feet outside, 12-feet inside.
- Hand sanitizer & hand washing will be available for all guests.
- State of the art air purifiers in each room.
- Doors and windows open to allow for plenty of fresh air (dress warm!).
- Hot touch points will be disinfected regularly.
- Touch-less payment systems.
- Curbside pick up available.
