

Since Gualala Arts was formed as a non-profit organization, it has become a vibrant and active arts association supporting a variety of programs for both residents and visitors to the area. The 15,000 square foot facility includes the 300 seat Coleman Auditorium (with a stage and dressing rooms) the Saville commercial kitchen, a control

room, the Howell Conference Room, the Mohr Mezzanine, classrooms, library, ceramics studio, the Burnett Art Gallery, and the Elaine Jacob Foyer. Outside areas include the JAMI Amphitheater with stage, the Karel Metcalf Garden Terrace, the DePrima Terrace, the Haiku Path, a hiking trail, a meditation area in magnificent redwoods, a barbecue area that seats 100 and a sculpture garden.

Our associated store, the Dolphin Gallery, is located in the center of Gualala in the Seacliff Center and is the showplace and retail outlet for the work of local artists. It also serves as an additional Visitor's Center where one can find information on restaurants and accommodations, local events and the best beach for the time of day and weather. The Gualala Arts Center is open daily from 11 a.m to 4 p.m.. Visitors are always welcome. The current calendar of exhibits, concerts, plays and classes can be found at GualalaArts.org, and in the E-Sketches newsletter. Membership is open to all. The Arts Center may be rented for weddings or private social events.

- Gualala Arts Summernationals Pinewood Derby will be Saturday, June 3, 2023 in the Gualala Arts Center Coleman Hall Send in your registration forms by May 27, to submit your racer for FREE. Registrations after June 3 and up to 9:45 a.m. on the day of the races will be \$10 per car. 2.
- Cars must pass inspection to qualify for race. Present your car for inspection from 10-11 am, Saturday, June 3. Only 1 entry per person 3. will be accepted for each classification, and the racer MUST BE PRESENT for their car to be entered and run in the races.
- 4. Vintage class and Unlimited class are open to racers of any age. For Vintage class, cars must have been previous Gualala Arts Pinewood Derby entries or built prior to January 2023. For Unlimited class, see rules below. Vintage and Unlimited classes will not be eligible for the Best Time Overall trophy.
- 5. All entries in each class will also be judged for their artistic execution, and each class will have a Most Artistic award presented to 1 entry. There will also be an overall Most Artistic award presented to a single car regardless of class.
- The Summernationals Pinewood Derby Awards Ceremony will immediately follow the completion of all races. 6.

### **Pinewood Derby Racing Trophies (each classification)** First Place, Second Place & Most Artistic Best Time Overall Trophy - All classifications except Vintage & Unlimited Most Artistic - All classifications

#### Pinewood Derby Rules

- 1. All cars must pass inspection to gualify for the race. The inspection points are as follows:
  - a. The car must have been made within the last 6 months prior to race and built primarily by the racer.
  - b. The width of the car shall not exceed 2 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> inches, including wheels.
  - c. The length of the car shall not exceed 7 inches.
  - d. The car must have at least 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> inches clearance between the wheels.
  - e. The car must have 3/8 inch clearance underneath the body so it does not rub on the track.
  - f. The weight of the car shall not exceed 5 ounces. For Unlimited class only, the weight of the car shall not exceed 13 ounces.
  - g. Axles, wheels and body wood shall be as provided in the kit. Only official BSA wheels are acceptable. The axles may be polished and/or lubricated with dry lubricant only. For Unlimited class only, these rules do not apply except for the use of dry lubricant, which is allowed. Body, wheels and axles can be made of any material (metal, ceramic, wood, combination of materials, etc.). Wheel dimensions cannot exceed 1 1/2" in diameter and 1/2" wide.
  - h. Wheel bearings, washers and bushings are prohibited. The wheels may not be cut, drilled, beveled or rounded. You may remove the seams and imperfections from the wheels. For Unlimited class only, these rules do not apply.
  - i. The car shall not ride on any type of springs.
  - j. Any details added must be within length, width and weight limits.
  - k. The car must be freewheeling, with no starting or propulsion devices.
  - I. No loose materials of any kind (i.e. lead shot) are allowed in the car.

- m. Weights (if used) must be permanently attached to the car. Weights held on by any kind of tape (Scotch, duct, cellophane, etc) are not permitted and will be removed during inspection.
- 2. Once a car passes inspection and is entered in the race, only race committee members can touch it.
- 3. Each heat and race will be announced. The starter will make sure the cars are on the track properly and then will start the race.
- 4. All cars will race a minimum of 4 races within a heat, running once on each lane of the track. The winning car in each classification will be the car with the lowest total Elapsed Time for all races it completes.
- 5. One (1) Best Time Overall Trophy will be awarded to the car with the lowest total Elapsed Time among all classifications except Vintage and Unlimited.
- 6. All racing cars must be official Pinewood Derby Kit cars which can be purchased for \$12.50 from Gualala Arts Center (GualalaArts.org), 46501 Old State Hwy, Gualala, 707-884-1138, the Scout Shop (RedwoodBSA.org), 1000 Apollo Way, Suite 106, Santa Rosa, 707-546-1013. Kits may also be purchased online or from other stores, but must be Pinewood Derby Approved. For Unlimited class only, this rule does not apply. See rules 1.f, 1.g and 1.h for allowable exceptions.
